DON MASK IN FACILITIES WHEN:

- MORE THAN TWO ARE PRESENT IN A ROOM,
- IN COMMON SPACE FOR MORE THAN 15 MINUTES WITH WINDOWS CLOSED,
- SOCIAL DISTANCE CAN NOT BE MAINTAINED.

WHEN UNMASKED IN FACILITIES:

- MAINTAIN 6 FOOT SOCIAL DISTANCE AT ALL TIMES.
- KEEP FAN RUNNING AND OPEN WINDOWS.

IN AIRCRAFT:

- WEAR A MASK UNLESS ALL ONBOARD ARE IDENTIFIED TO BE FULLY VACCINATED AND ACCEPT TO UNMASK AT THEIR OWN RISK.

COCKPIT SANITIZATION:

- DISINFECTANT WIPE CANISTERS ARE KEPT IN THE AIRCRAFT AND IN THE OFFICE.
- DISINFECT SHARED HEADSETS (MIKE, BOOM, PADS, EAR CUPS).
- KEEP CABIN VENTILATION HIGH. DRESS ACCORDINGLY AS NEEDED.

SELF ISOLATE AND DO NOT ENTER IF FEEL OR SUSPECT COLD SYMPTOMS UNTIL NEGATIVE PCR TEST IN HAND.

GOVERNMENT ESSENTIAL BUSINESS GUIDANCE

April 17, 2020 CISA Memo p 13 Supporting Flight Instruction Activities

Essential Critical Infrastructure Workforce

- Automotive repair, maintenance, and transportation equipment manufacturing and distribution facilities (including those who repair and maintain electric vehicle charging stations).
- Transportation safety inspectors, including hazardous material inspectors and accident investigator inspectors.
- Manufacturers and distributors (to include service centers and related operations) of lighting and communication systems, specialized signage and structural systems, emergency response equipment and support materials, printers, printed materials, packaging materials, pallets, crates, containers, and other supplies needed to support manufacturing, packaging staging and distribution operations, and other critical infrastructure needs.
- Postal Service, parcel, courier, last-mile delivery, and shipping and related workers, to include private companies, who accept, process, transport, and deliver information and goods.
- Workers who supply equipment and materials for maintenance of transportation equipment.
- Workers who repair and maintain vehicles, aircraft, rail equipment, marine vessels, bicycles, and the equipment and infrastructure that enables operations that encompass movement of cargo and passengers.
- Workers who support air transportation for cargo and passengers, including operation distribution, maintenance, and sanitation. This includes air traffic controllers, flight dispatchers, maintenance personnel, ramp workers, fueling agents, flight crews, airport safety inspectors and engineers, airport operations personnel, aviation and aerospace safety workers, security, commercial space personnel, operations personnel, accident investigators, flight instructors, and other on- and off-airport facilities workers.
- Workers supporting transportation via inland waterways, such as barge crew, dredging crew, and river port workers for essential goods.

3rd Update Guidance for Flight Schools

Greetings, Aviation Colleague. This email is being sent to individuals, businesses and airport owners/operators in Maryland that have inquired on the essential status of flight schools in MD during the State of Emergency.

For historical context, previous notices on essential business determination is on the email thread below.

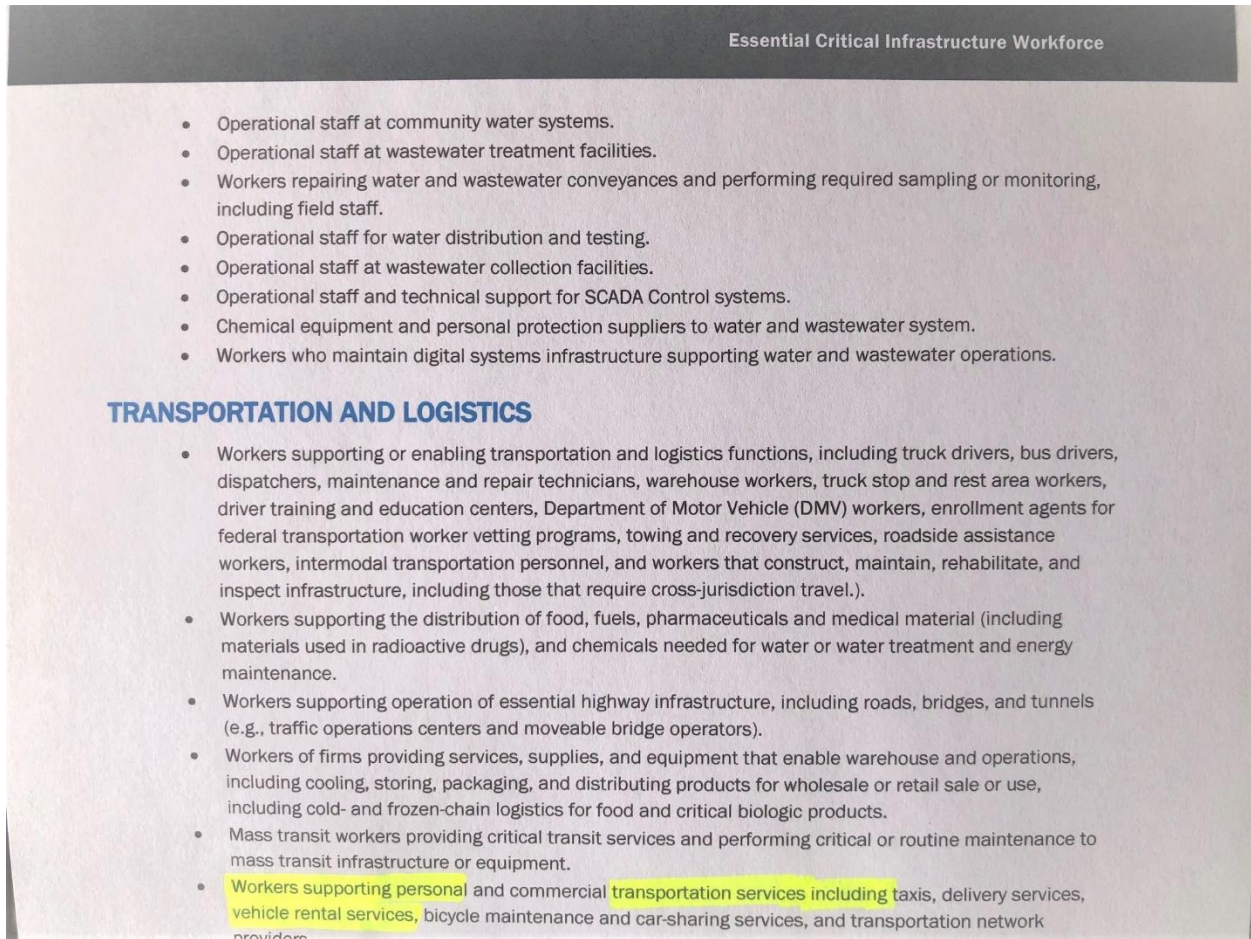
The April 17, 2020 CISA memo, page 13, 7th bullet from top, includes flight instructors, and by extension flight schools, as an "essential critical infrastructure workforce". With the Gov's March 30, 2020 EO for stay at home referencing the CISA listing of essential businesses, flight schools and flight instructors are accepted as essential businesses.

If in doubt of a business' essential status, the Gov's web site has legal interpretive guidance. Suggest reviewing interpretive guidance # COVID19-06 when non-essential status is unclear. In addition, recommend flight schools provide letters to employees to carry on their person IAW interpretive guidance # COVID19-08.
